BAPTISM: Baptisms are scheduled once a month on Sunday afternoons except during Lent. Expectant parents are asked to contact the rectory to schedule an appointment at least three months before the desired date of Baptism. Parents must attend a special catechetical session prior to the Baptism.

MARRIAGE: Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the proposed wedding date in order to allow for the proper pre-marital preparation. At least one person must be a registered parishioner of Holy Family.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK: This is a sacrament not only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, we encourage you to call for a priest in the rectory.

MINISTRY OF THE SICK: The Eucharist will be brought to the homebound. Please contact the Rectory with the names and addresses of parishioners who are ill or homebound.

My brothers and sisters in the Lord!

As we focus on today's Gospel, we realize it is worth remembering that the faith of the Apostles was no overnight experience but something gradual, which increased as they became more intimate with Jesus. The same is true with our faith; it will grow and deepen provided we are more Christ-like in our daily living. The biggest obstacle of spreading Christian faith today is not so much intellectual doubt as the unchristian lifestyles paraded by so many of us who regard ourselves as good Christians. Today we begin our Parish Mission and the focus is on this special gift of mercy. I challenge you to join us these next 3 days - - Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, at 7:00 PM, as Fr. Raphael leads us in this spiritual journey of mercy.

We welcome Fr. Raphael this week and I ask that you invite family and friends to join us, most especially if they have been away from Church.



The Great Mission



During this Easter season we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. This event impels us, as Christians, to announce this glorious Good News to the whole world. In celebration of this *Year of Mercy*, proclaimed by Pope Francis, many Catholics throughout the world will be responding by embarking on a Great Mission to announce the Gospel to the whole world in the streets and public spaces. The past three years, our Holy Father Pope Francis has encouraged the brethren to go to the public squares in Buenos Aires and do this mission, announcing the love of Christ to everyone and the good news that death has been vanquished and the gates of Heaven are now open! 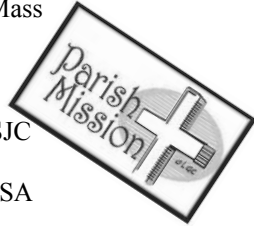

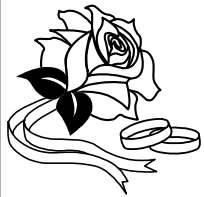
