**From the  
Pastor**

My brothers and sisters in the Lord!

All of today's readings deal with the question of humanity's search for, and the encounter with, divinity. And yet, in the experience of the people of God, that search is turned upside down. Today's scriptures show us that it is not that humanity is able to seek and find God by its powers but, rather, it is God who allows God's self to be discovered by us. And usually we encounter God in the most unexpected places and ways.

In the first reading we see Elijah on the run, in fear for his life, being hunted down by the pagan queen, Jezebel. Elijah has about all he can take and pleads with God to take his life. But on Mount Horeb he is given a rare privilege of having an encounter with the Lord, who is not found in the midst of the traditional places which one might expect: a mighty wind, a devastating earthquake, or even a fire. Instead, God is found in the gentleness of a breeze, which is sometimes translated as, "a still, small voice" or even "the silence." It is there that Elijah has that encounter with the Living God.

Sometimes, in our own lives, we can find ourselves like Elijah and Peter, at the end of our rope, living in fear or full of doubts and, perhaps, maybe wishing that it would all end and go away. At times, like Elijah, we discover that we don't find God where we expect Him to be, in the places or celebrating the rituals where we may have been comforted by the Lord's presence in the past. Or, like Peter, the storms of our life may mean that we are too busy struggling, simply to survive, that we are not able to lift up our eyes to recognize the loving Father who is already walking toward us in the midst of our personal battles.

My brothers and sisters, we must realize that God comes to us unexpectedly; in the silence and in the middle of our business and fear, as well as in times of our tiredness, brokenness, doubts and desperation. The Lord invites us to come out of the darkness of the caves of our lives, to step out into the security of our little boats and place our complete trust in Him. Our God is faithful to us and is always there reaching out to us, whether it be in the gentleness of the wind and the silence, or in the storms and fears, with His strong hand, He is ready to save us. His words to us remain unchanged: "Courage! It is I! Do not be afraid!"

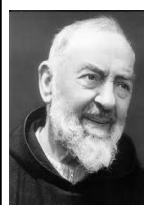

**INTERVIEW WITH THE AUGUST STEWARD OF THE MONTH**

**Anthony Pesci**

Anthony Pesci was born and raised in Nutley. He attended Little Sheep Nursery, Yanticaw School, John H. Walker Middle School and Nutley High School. He's currently attending Montclair State University and is working towards a degree and career in Health Care.

Anthony's stewardship was founded in the traditional values of his family. Growing up, Anthony always learned that people are supposed to help people and that's what he has always wanted to do. He found his passion and found God by helping people do what is right whenever he could. "Being able to help people is an experience all on its own," shares Anthony.

Three years ago, Anthony was able to achieve certification as an EMT (Emergency Medical Technician). He was inspired to become an EMT when he lost a friend during an accident and thought he could have made a difference had he been trained. He is currently a member of the Nutley Volunteer Emergency and Rescue Squad. Additionally, he was instrumental in getting Fr. John Gordon to be the Chaplain of the Rescue Squad.

Another traditional value passed on from his parents was going to church on Sundays. Growing up, he always attended the 8:00 AM mass with his parents. His brother, Rich, was an altar server and Anthony watched him while sitting in the pew and wanted to be an altar server as well. When he was old enough, he signed up to become an altar server and was trained by Fr. Giovanni. He recalls that it was easy to learn because Fr. Giovanni made it so much fun. Anthony was an altar server from 2002 to 2007, a sacristan from 2007 to 2010 and then head sacristan from 2010 to 2013. "I loved being near the altar and even considered becoming a priest at one time. I followed my family, my parents and my brother. Because of that, I found lots of opportunities," shares Anthony.

It was also following his family when he was 12 years old that led Anthony to the next chapter of his stewardship journey. Anthony would accompany his parents when they would drop off his brother and sister, Rich and Christina, at the Youth Group meetings in the St. Joseph Center. While there, he met his brother's and sister's friends in the Youth Group and saw that it was a lot of fun. He enjoyed all aspects of the Youth Group experience, the fun moments and the soulful moments, while being surrounded by friends and family. Although there was an age requirement of being 13 years old to join the Youth Group, they allowed him to join earlier because of his enthusiasm. "They made me feel so welcome," said Anthony.

Anthony was a member of the Youth Group from 2007 to 2011. He attended the Canada retreats in which members of the Youth Group assisted disabled adults participating on the retreat. He also assisted at Leadership Retreats with Mike and Faith Rose at which time he presented two talks: "Who Am I," regarding choices people make and finding God in tough times, and "Masks," which discussers ways we cover up our true selves.

Anthony also represented the youth of our parish as a member of the Pastoral Council from 2011 to 2012 and is presently a member of the Knight of Columbus.

"Do what you're comfortable with. As long as you're happy, follow your heart and where your feet lead you. Close your eyes and take the first step. Be bold, be unique, be yourself." – Anthony Pesci
