



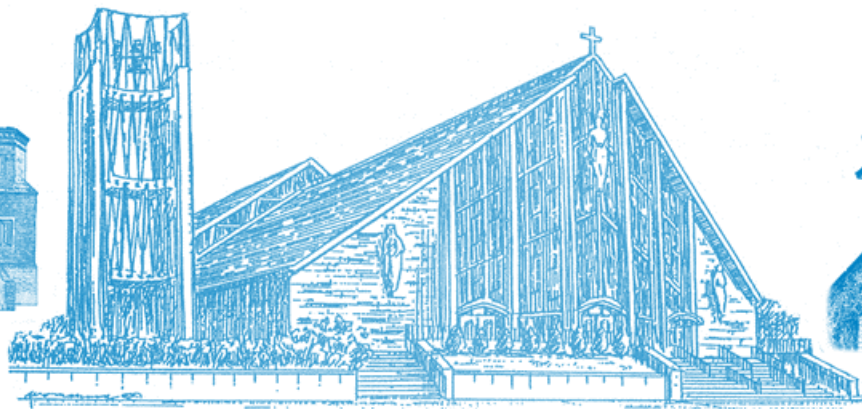

**BAPTISM:** Baptisms are scheduled once a month on Sunday afternoons except during Lent. Expectant parents are asked to contact the rectory to schedule an appointment at least three months before the desired date of Baptism. Parents must attend a special catechetical session prior to the Baptism.

**MARRIAGE:** Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the proposed wedding date in order to allow for the proper pre-marital preparation. At least one person must be a registered parishioner of Holy Family.

**ANOIDING OF THE SICK:** This is a sacrament not only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, we encourage you to call for a priest in the rectory.

**MINISTRY OF THE SICK:** The Eucharist will be brought to the homebound. Please contact the Rectory with the names and addresses of parishioners who are ill or homebound.

**VOCATION:** Women and men who feel called to the religious life, and men called to Holy Orders, should contact the Vocations Office at 973-497-4365.

**EMERGENCY CALLS:** In case of an accident or sudden illness, call the rectory at any hour or reach us on the emergency phone, 973-715-3108. The priest on duty will return your call.

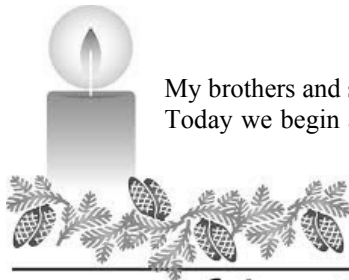

### First Sunday of Advent 1, Cycle B, 2014



My brothers and sisters in the Lord!

Today we begin a new liturgical year with the new Season of Advent. As we look around the church, we can sense that things are different. The fall flowers are gone, the liturgical color of green now changed to the deeper blue-purple (Sarem Blue) of Advent reminding us that the nights are growing longer. We now find the Advent Wreath with four candles waiting to be lit, inviting us and enlightening us in some way as we enter this new season of anticipation. This is a new *church year* as well as a *new season* in the life of the church. We also need to remind ourselves that this is not the *Christmas Season* or even the *holiday season*, even though it might be called these by the secular society. **The Christmas Season, in the Catholic Church, begins at the Christmas Eve Vigil Mass, December 24, and ends on the Baptism of the Lord which is January 11, 2015.**

Today we mark the beginning of the *Advent Season* and, while we remember that Jesus is always with us, the prayers and the scriptures proclaimed at the Masses during Advent direct our focus toward the anticipation and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ while also remembering with celebration His First Coming.

Advent is not necessarily a penitential season in the same way that Lent is – but Advent is still a time to take stock and, perhaps, seek the Sacrament of Reconciliation and certainly pray for an inner conversion of our hearts. Yes, it is a new season. We have a new chance right now to open our hearts to the Lord, to dwell on the meaning of the Sacred Scriptures and to reflect on the meaning of the words we offer at Mass. In Advent and always, let us heed the Master’s challenge to be “watchful and alert” at all times.

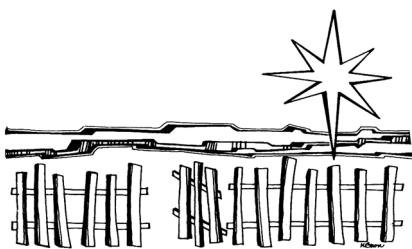

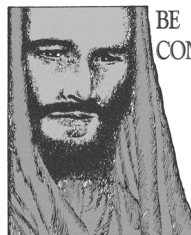

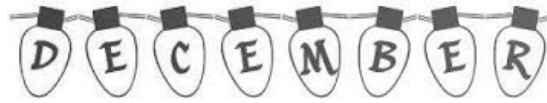

• No need to put bows or ribbons on the gifts. Just attach the gift tag from the tree (or a description on your own tags) so we know where to best distribute the gift.

• If you are answering a request for a gift card or stamps or some other small item, PLEASE box or bag the gift as envelopes can be too easily mislaid.

• Spend only what your means allow, but no more than \$25 should be spent on any gift.

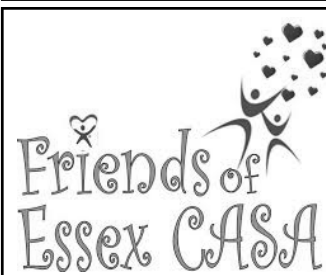
