My brothers and sisters in the Lord,

Today we see that when Jesus began His public ministry in His home town, the initial reaction of the local community to His preaching was very favorable. He spoke fluently and with simplicity but also with authority and they loved His words when they first heard them. But as time passed, they began to feel threatened because they realized that they were being challenged to change their ways. The message of Jesus was becoming a disturbing one and they could not accept it.

We see them in a mad frenzy; they ganged up against Him and made an attempt on His life. When Jesus made the comment that no prophet is ever accepted in his own native place, He was clearly identifying Himself with the long line of prophets who suffered a similar fate. He was not in the popularity game. He had come to preach the Good News regardless of how it was received. What happened that day in Nazareth would be repeated, over and over again, during His ministry with the final outcome being His crucifixion.

Although today's gospel is about the rejection of Jesus Christ, the greatest prophet of all, the work of prophecy continues in every generation as people are invited to witness to Jesus not simply with words but with their lives. The mission of Jesus points to our mission which we receive at baptism, to witness to the values which He represents. As Christians, each one of us is, by nature, an apostle to whom God has entrusted other people. We are to take a stand with Jesus against friend and foe and often stand against our own weaknesses. At home it might be the call to love more tenderly, showing patience when irritated by short comings among family, friends and neighbors, and a readiness to excuse and overlook sharp words as we journey through the many challenges of life.

God has called us to this particular work but He has not promised us easy success or popularity. There will be those moments when we will have to stand up and be counted and our moral worth will be severely tested. To go against the trend and shake people out of their complacency may not be well received but there is the call to be a prophet. People can become too comfortable in their sin and they resent interference. As it was with Jesus, so it is with His church. Jesus is in every one of us. Either we honor Him or deny His presence, but we must remember that what we do to Him is done to ourselves.

Today we begin celebrating Catholic Schools Week. Please stop by our School, Good Shepherd Academy, for Open House and see all the wonderful things happening there.

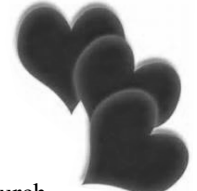
