**19<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time C-2016**

My brothers and sisters in the Lord!

Through all of today's readings, there runs a theme of trust and of a readiness that enables us to welcome God wherever we encounter Him. It is, in fact, recognition, a knowing, for He is there already.

In the Book of Wisdom, the author speaks of the joyful confidence in the future that God's promise gives to his people. What threatens to defeat them will be overcome by the power of God, who is always with him.

The writer of the Letter to the Hebrews reminds us that neither Abraham nor his wife, Sarah, knew what the future would hold. How, at her old age, could she conceive? Where was this Promised Land to which they were being led as strangers? Yet both were sustained by their faith in God's promises to them and became part of salvation history of the Jewish people.

These were people like us and their stories were much like our own. We search, we question, we are often fearful, and our tomorrows may feel out of our control. How wonderfully comforting are those words of Jesus, "Fear not, little flock, for it has pleased your Father to give you the kingdom."

The disciples must have wondered how they could ever achieve the purpose for which Jesus had called them. The forces opposing them were apparent and the one upon whom they had depended so much spoke of leaving them. They needed to realize they were not striving for political victory, nor working for earthly riches. Their hearts could be where their treasure was because the treasure was already in their hearts. The Kingdom of Heaven is within and they were to enter into a victory already won.

They were not to be afraid but neither were they to be complacent. They were to be ready for the climax that could come upon them at any time. Like servants keeping vigil for a master's return or a householder guarding against thieves, so were they to be prepared for the coming of the Son of Man.

We see Peter as being puzzled and wondering what they were being warned about. Was it an imminent catastrophe or some trial a long way off in the future that would test their faith? Jesus' words are spoken in the context of His approaching death, and what would be for His followers, a terrible and bewildering loss. It would be one for which they needed to be strengthened and prepared.

We live in a world which is so unpredictable and our future is unknown; neither about the everyday things we do nor about the wider world. We have no absolute certainty nor can we be sure that our plans will succeed. We have the proof of the last few weeks: the senseless death of the Dallas Police Officers, the train tragedy in Italy, the tragic slaughter of so many innocent people in Nice, France, the murder of Fr. Jacques Hamel last Tuesday as he was celebrating Mass in northern France, as well as the many tragedies we never hear even about. We want so many things; we treasure so many things. How can we, therefore, stand before the unknown? But is it so really unknown? The past, the present, and the future, are all in the timelessness of God; He is our treasure and we both possess Him and are possessed by Him. We can take to ourselves those words of Christ: "Fear not, little flock, it has pleased your Father to give you the kingdom." It is only in Him that we are safe.
