



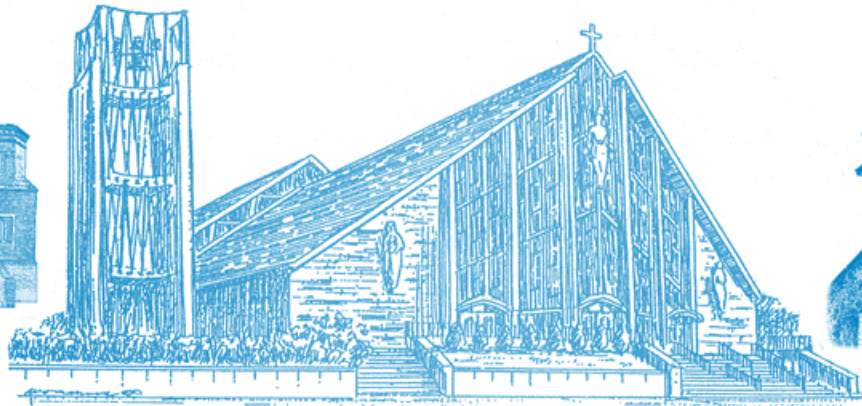

**MARRIAGE:** Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the proposed wedding date in order to allow for the proper pre-marital preparation. At least one person must be a registered parishioner of Holy Family.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** This is a sacrament not only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, we encourage you to call for a priest in the rectory.

**MINISTRY OF THE SICK:** The Eucharist will be brought to the homebound. Please contact the Rectory with the names and addresses of parishioners who are ill or homebound.

**VOCATION:** Women and men who feel called to the religious life, and men called to Holy Orders, should contact the Vocations Office at 973-497-4365.

**EMERGENCY CALLS:** In case of an accident or sudden illness, call the rectory at any hour or reach us on the emergency phone, 973-986-1690. The priest on duty will return your call.

**OBEDIENCE TO THE COMMANDMENT IS THE WAY TO LIFE**

Homily for the 22<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

Once upon a time, I entered Uber from an airport and, to my amazement, the driver was not using her seat belt. I felt very uneasy because I could not think of driving without my seat belt. When I asked why she was not using the safety device, she told me about her dislike for seat belts and, in my mind, I imagined that she disliked her life too. I was still trying to convince her about the safety benefits of using a seat belt when she began to adjust her seat belt and, looking ahead, I could see police on the road flagging down cars and directing them to a detour at a road maintenance spot. She was afraid of being caught and punished for breaking a driving law, so she adjusted her seat belt.

Most people fear the law and the reason is not far-fetched because it often punishes defaulters. However, the ideal purpose of the law is not to punish but to regulate, guide, and protect those who are subject to its prescriptions. We could, therefore, define the law as a set of rules that regulate the actions of those who are subject to its promulgation.

There is hardly any aspect of life that is not regulated by some set of rules. Humans, animals and plants exist by responding to both natural and conventional laws. In the First Reading today (Deut. 4:1-2, 6-8), Moses tells the people of Israel to observe (without addition or subtraction) the statues and decrees he was giving them so that they could live and enter to possess the land that God is giving to them. Furthermore, he tells them that paying attention to the commandments would increase their value before God and the nations around them.

In the Second Reading (James 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27), the apostle takes the matter further by instructing that action should imitate the observance of the law, "be doers of the word not hearers only." This message is for all of us. Most of us can recite the commandments of by heart but how often do they resonate with our daily lives?

In the Gospel Reading (Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23), our Lord Jesus Christ supports the instructions of James by making a destination between religious observance and spiritual life when some detractors quizzed him about the negligence of the ritual of the washing of hands before meals by the apostles. It is what comes out of our hearts that could make or unmake us, not the cleanliness of the physical hands nor the food we eat. May we pay attention to the pure religion which involves obeying the law of love and charity, and total detachment from sin. God bless you!

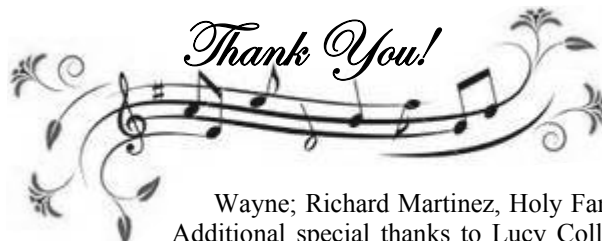

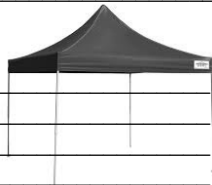
