**BAPTISM:** Baptisms are scheduled once a month on Sunday afternoons except during Lent. Expectant parents are asked to contact the rectory to schedule an appointment at least three months before the desired date of Baptism. Parents must attend a special catechetical session prior to the Baptism.

**MARRIAGE:** Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the proposed wedding date in order to allow for the proper pre-marital preparation. At least one person must be a registered parishioner of Holy Family.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** This is a sacrament not only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, we encourage you to call for a priest in the rectory.

**MINISTRY OF THE SICK:** The Eucharist will be brought to the homebound. Please contact the Rectory with the names and addresses of parishioners who are ill or homebound.

**VOCATION:** Women and men who feel called to the religious life, and men called to Holy Orders, should contact the Vocations Office at 973-497-4365.

**EMERGENCY CALLS:** In case of an accident or sudden illness, call the rectory at any hour or reach us on the emergency phone, 973-986-1690. The priest on duty will return your call.

*From the Desk of Fr. Mauro...*

My Brothers & Sisters:

"You are not far from the kingdom of God," replies Jesus to the scribe who understood the commandment which is at the beginning of the law. It is not far but, to enter, one thing is missing: to love Jesus. The passage concludes by saying that no one dared to question Him. Our silence will force Him to provoke us so that we may begin a dialogue with Him in order to understand who He is: **He is the Lord.**

The purpose and meaning of our life is to love God and unite ourselves with Him becoming by grace what He is by nature. Love for Him is the way to Holiness, one becomes what he loves. God is not only a mother and a father, respectively, a necessary love that gives life; He is also a spouse, to whom we are called to unite ourselves.

Our sin was to ignore this love, turning its back on it. Jesus has come to reconcile us with Him, through His death on the cross, so that everyone can see Him and thus know the power of the God of the living.

Jesus has only one power: that of giving Himself totally to us; thus expecting our response and acceptance. Disciple is one who recognizes and believes in the love that God has for him in Jesus.

We have tried to make the transition as seamless as possible. Either log on to [www.parishgiving.org](http://www.parishgiving.org) or call 866-307-7140 to sign up. You can then establish your account and set up your annual donations in a matter of minutes.

Next, sign into your account on WeShare and print out all your year-to-date donations for 2018 tax filing purposes as ParishGiving can only provide a statement for donations made through them. Lastly, call WeShare at 800-950-9952 and tell them to cancel your donations going forward and **e-mail a confirmation of the cancellation to you.**

And that's it - - you're good to go! For those new to the service, simply click on the link on the website and establish your account. It's that easy.

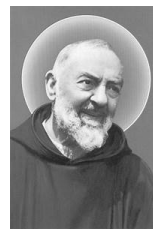

**TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION**

Just two years ago, we engaged in one of the core activities of our democratic system: a presidential election. Actually, the institution of election can be traced to traditions in the Church, and although bishops are no longer chosen in this way, abbots and abbesses (heads of monastic communities) have almost always been elected by full voting members of their communities. The lifetime appointment begins when the monks or nuns are gathered in “chapter” at the death or resignation of the abbot, and fortunately for all involved, campaigning is not allowed! The members of the community discern, with prayer to the Holy Spirit, who among them is the best suited for leadership. Once chosen, the new leader requests the blessing of the local bishop, who usually presides at a ceremony of consecration or investiture. The ballots are always secret, and a simple majority must be achieved.

In our American system the Electoral College is the determining voice in the presidential election, not the popular election on a November Tuesday, just as the monastic chapter is the electorate. Today, most religious orders elect general superiors in “chapter” by delegates of the professed members, and usually for a term of six years. A few, like the Jesuits, elect for life. At least we don’t have that weight on our shoulders when we choose a president. Four years at a time will do!

#### Who should attend "Protecting God's Children"

- **Babysitters** — individuals who care for young children during Sunday Mass, meetings etc.
- **Home Chore Program** — helpers who go into homes of the elderly and disabled to clean, shop, carry out repairs
- **Ministry to the Dying** — respite care givers, house cleaners, babysitters and others who minister to those at the end of life and their families.
- **Music Ministry** — choir directors, coordinators of children and youth music programs, helpers and others who have contact with children and youth including adult choir members if children or youth regularly or occasionally sing or play instruments in the choir.
- **Parish Health Care** — nurses, home health aides, drivers and any others who volunteer to serve the sick of the parish. Pastoral Visitation To The Sick And Homebound Eucharistic Ministers, friendly visitors, pastoral visitors and others who minister in the name of the community, to the sick, homebound or disabled in their homes or at a care facility.
- **Religious Education** — catechists, substitute teachers, assistants, babysitters and other Religious Education support staff serving the children and youth of the parish.
- **Scouting** — leaders and others involved with Boy Scout or Girl Scout Troops **IF** the parish charters the troop.
- **Worship Ministry** — Eucharistic Ministers, lectors, and ushers.
- **Youth Ministry** — CORE, chaperones, leaders, drivers, instructors, coordinators, coaches, referees and others who serve parish youth.
