

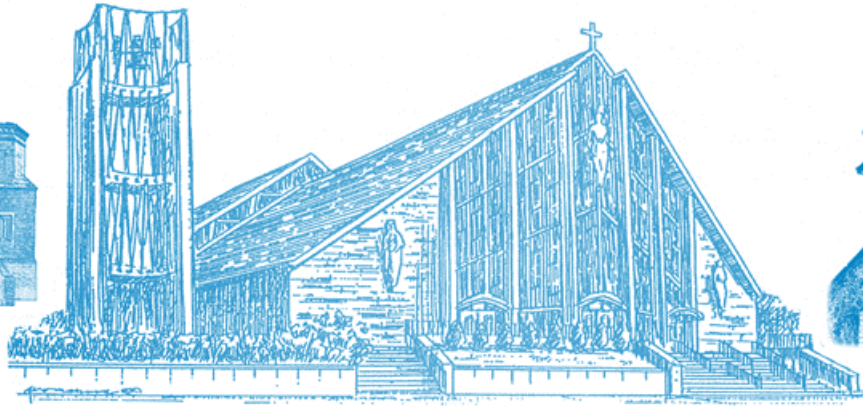

BAPTISM: Baptisms are scheduled once a month on Sunday afternoons except during Lent. Expectant parents are asked to contact the rectory to schedule an appointment at least three months before the desired date of Baptism. Parents must attend a special catechetical session prior to the Baptism.

MARRIAGE: Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the proposed wedding date in order to allow for the proper pre-marital preparation. At least one person must be a registered parishioner of Holy Family.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK: This is a sacrament not only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, we encourage you to call for a priest in the rectory.

MINISTRY OF THE SICK: The Eucharist will be brought to the homebound. Please contact the Rectory with the names and addresses of parishioners who are ill or homebound.

VOCATION: Women and men who feel called to the religious life, and men called to Holy Orders, should contact the Vocations Office at 973-497-4365.

EMERGENCY CALLS: In case of an accident or sudden illness, call the rectory at any hour or reach us on the emergency phone, 973-986-1690. The priest on duty will return your call.

A Message from Fr. Mauro...

The Epiphany of the Lord - Year C, 2019

My brothers and sisters,

The history of the Magi has always struck popular piety. They have become "kings", at the suggestion of Is 60.3 and of Psalm 72, 10. Their number, in our tradition, has become 3 according to the gifts they offered. They represent *Sem, Cam and Jafet*, the sons of Noah, all of humanity, the first fruits of the Church. Their relics are to be found in Köln, Germany, the prized loot that Barbarossa took from the church of S. Eustorgio in 1164 before destroying Milan. Their names became *Gaspere, Melchiorre and Baldassarre* which, in certain regions at the beginning of the New Year, are written on doors to protect men and animals. Their fortune is linked to the fact that we, coming to the faith from paganism, identify with them.

The main themes of the story are two: the wisdom that leads to revelation and the revelation that manifests to all the Messiah of Israel, light for the people. The piece traces the path to meet it. Having already been born, it is a question of discovering "where" it can be found.

The Savior is, first of all, present in the star which depicts wisdom, the principle of all research. This leads to Jerusalem: wisdom opens to revelation - and the Savior is present in Scripture, which makes known in what direction to look. Following His directions, the star reappears with new light: reason is illuminated by revelation and knows who He seeks. The joy of the heart finally indicates precisely "where" He is. It is there that one adores Him and opens His own treasure - and the Lord is present in adoration (= bringing-to-mouth), in the kiss of communion with Him, and in the treasure of one who gives as He gave Himself.

Although we know the material place "where" Jesus was born, it is not enough. We must personally take the itinerary of the Magi, with the effort of a nocturnal journey full of charm and fear, of desires and doubts, of hopes and uncertainties, under the guidance of a mobile star that appears and disappears. Otherwise we are like Herod, who wants to kill Him, or like the scribes and priests - whose knowledge serves to give indications to those who kill The Church, as well as Jews, is also made by pagans who, like the Magi, make the journey of research until they find it, kiss it and open their treasure to Him.

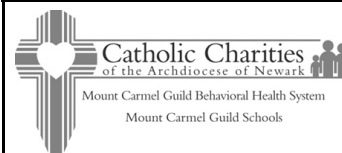
Rosary Altar Society

Then sign into your account on WeShare and print out all your year-to-date donations for 2018 tax filing purposes as ParishGiving can only provide a statement for donations made through them. At that point, call WeShare at 800-950-9952 and tell them to cancel your donations going forward and **e-mail a confirmation of the cancellation to you**. And that's it - - you're good to go! For those new to the service, simply click on the link on the website and establish your account. It's that easy.
