

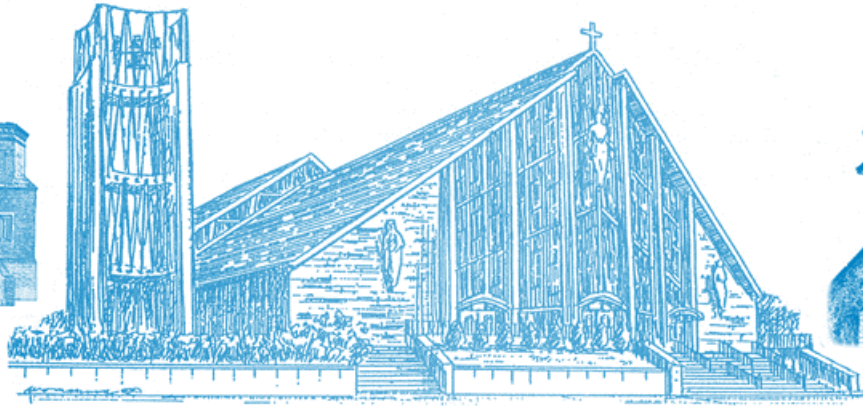

RECONCILIATION: Saturday, 1:00 PM

BAPTISM: Baptisms are scheduled once a month on Sunday afternoons except during Lent. Expectant parents are asked to contact the rectory to schedule an appointment at least three months before the desired date of Baptism. Parents must attend a special catechetical session prior to the Baptism.

MARRIAGE: Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the proposed wedding date in order to allow for the proper pre-marital preparation. At least one person must be a registered parishioner of Holy Family.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK: This is a sacrament not only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, we encourage you to call for a priest in the rectory.

MINISTRY OF THE SICK: The Eucharist will be brought to the homebound. Please contact the Rectory with the names and addresses of parishioners who are ill or homebound.

VOCATION: Women and men who feel called to the religious life, and men called to Holy Orders, should contact the Vocations Office at 973-497-4365.

EMERGENCY CALLS: In case of an accident or sudden illness, call the rectory at any hour or reach us on the emergency phone, 973-986-1690. The priest on duty will return your call.

4th Sunday in Ordinary Time – C- 2019

My brothers and sisters in the Lord!

Today's Gospel passage is quite interesting as it starts off with everyone approving of Jesus' words and then ends up with the same people trying to throw Jesus off a cliff. We ask what it was that Jesus had said that would upset these people so much. He basically referred to the widow of Sidon, and Naaman the Syrian, reminding the people that the whole point of having a *chosen people* is that they are supposed to be a witness to God's goodness in the world, as well as being an example to others. God's choosing the children of Israel was not so that they could benefit exclusively from God's favor but so that they could mediate God's presence to other people. This was symbolized also by the fact that Solomon's temple, the dwelling place of God on earth, was built by craftsmen who were not Jewish. The bringing of Gentiles was always part of God's plan.

The people of Jesus' home town of Nazareth seem to have forgotten this aspect of their faith. God does not choose people or nations because they are good or lovable. It is then fitting that they should reflect the goodness and lovability of God to the world.

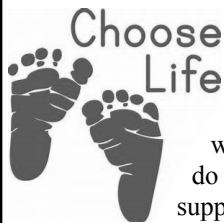
This can also be applied to the higher gifts that St. Paul talks about in the second reading today. Nobody *deserves* to receive the theological virtues of faith, hope and love; they are purely a gift from God. They are intended not just to sanctify us but to equip us to sanctify the world.

The *gift of faith* helps us to believe what God reveals about divine nature. It comes to the aid of our intellect. The *gift of hope* gives us a real trust in God's promises as well as our future happiness with God.

The *gift of love* is the gift that makes all other gifts live. We will not need faith in heaven when we see God face to face. We will not need hope as we will have gained what we were hoping for. Love is the one virtue that will come to complete fulfillment and endure for all eternity. Love is the gift which helps us to understand that God's love is for everyone and that we can be witnesses to God's love in the world.

We can nurture these gifts in various ways. Learning more about our faith helps that gift and strengthens our minds. Meditating upon the joy of eternal life enlivens our hope. Living a sacramental life in the Church and doing good works helps increase the love of God within us; and so we are enabled to fulfill our calling to spread God's love in our world.

Protect Viable Babies Postcard Campaign a Big Success + Follow-up Phone Call!!

Last weekend, our parish participated in the postcard campaign to ask our NJ State Representatives to support the Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act (A-1686/S-537) which would protect babies in the womb at 20 weeks (5 months) and beyond. (This is just the first step in protecting all babies in the womb.) The campaign was a big success! Our parish alone sent 1,300 postcards to our elected officials! There is one more thing you can do to help protect babies in the womb: Call your one State Senator and two Assembly Members and ask them to support the "Pain Capable" Act (A-1686/S-537).

This is mandatory. We have tried to make the transition as seamless as possible. First, go to our website (www.holyfamilynutley.org) and click on the link to ParishGiving. You can then establish your account and set up your annual donations in a matter of minutes. Then sign into your account on WeShare and print out all your year-to-date donations for 2018 tax filing purposes as ParishGiving can only provide a statement for donations made through them. At that point, call WeShare at 800-950-9952 and tell them to cancel your donations going forward and **e-mail a confirmation of the cancellation to you.** And that's it - - you're good to go! For those new to the service, simply click on the link on the website and establish your account. It's that easy.
