

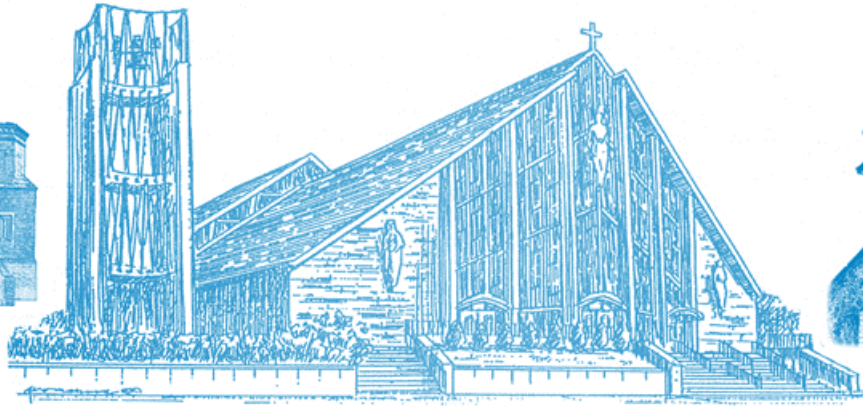

BAPTISM: Baptisms are scheduled once a month on Sunday afternoons except during Lent. Expectant parents are asked to contact the rectory to schedule an appointment at least three months before the desired date of Baptism. Parents must attend a special catechetical session prior to the Baptism.

MARRIAGE: Couples should contact the rectory one year in advance of the proposed wedding date in order to allow for the proper pre-marital preparation. At least one person must be a registered parishioner of Holy Family.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK: This is a sacrament not only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, we encourage you to call for a priest in the rectory.

MINISTRY OF THE SICK: The Eucharist will be brought to the homebound. Please contact the Rectory with the names and addresses of parishioners who are ill or homebound.

VOCATION: Women and men who feel called to the religious life, and men called to Holy Orders, should contact the Vocations Office at 973-497-4365.

EMERGENCY CALLS: In case of an accident or sudden illness, call the rectory at any hour or reach us on the emergency phone, 973-986-1690. The priest on duty will return your call.

My brothers and sisters in the Lord!

Today's scripture passages are full of surprises about people chosen from God for particular tasks. The prophet Isaiah is a man of prayer who is familiar with the Temple. He is called by the Lord to become His prophet through whom He will name injustice, call kings to account and proclaim an unwelcome message that will meet resistance and opposition.

Paul is aware of his history and recalls how he persecuted the Christians and had Stephen put to death and how he might have wept in later life when he looked back at his misdirected zeal. The tears might have been from sorrow for his actions; they may have been of joy because of the way in which God had graced him to do God's will.

The central figure in today's Gospel is Simon Peter, the fisherman who is ready to acknowledge his sinfulness and asks the Lord to leave him in peace. But Peter's wishes are not God's will and he is called to be a disciple. In this moment of feeling very small and somewhat inadequate in the presence of Jesus, he is given a new mission and sent as an Apostle to call others to Christ. Jesus says; "Do not be afraid; from now on it is men you will catch."

Each of these men, Isaiah, Paul, and Peter, recognize their inadequacies in the face of God's call and God's will. Each one is created in the image and likeness of God and reflects an aspect of God's glory. Through God turning their lives upside down, they begin explicitly to proclaim the saving power of God and the message of God's kingdom. We see Isaiah moving from a fearful man to a bold preacher; Paul from persecutor of Christians to prophetic apostle; Peter from fisherman to a martyr in Rome. They remember the words of God: "Do not be afraid."

The calling of Isaiah, Paul and Peter is clearly to proclaim the message of the kingdom of God. However, at the time of their deaths, human minds might have questioned their achievements. In spite of Isaiah's preaching, the land of Israel was conquered. Peter and Paul died as martyrs in Rome, one on a cross the other by a sword. It's only later that we see their achievements in the light of the resurrection.

Most of us in life do not receive medals or become like Isaiah, Paul or Peter. However, each of us is given gifts by God to use for the good of others. We are witnesses and when we can speak of God's grace at work in ourselves, we can be recognized clearly as Catholics and Christians. We are lights in the world who can share our hope with others to allow our light to shine out; we can take courage from the words of Jesus, "DO NOT BE AFRAID."

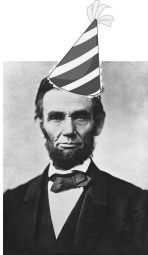

We have tried to make the transition as seamless as possible. First, go to our website (www.holyfamilynutley.org) and click on the link to Parish Giving. You can then establish your account and set up your annual donations in a matter of minutes. Then sign into your account on WeShare and print out all your year-to-date donations for 2018 tax filing purposes as Parish Giving can only provide a statement for donations made through them. At that point, call WeShare at 800-950-9952 and tell them to cancel your donations going forward and **e-mail a confirmation of the cancellation to you.** And that's it - - you're good to go!
